Tecpro Systems Limited Receives Orders Worth Rs. 1978 crore

- BoP order worth Rs. 1,255.0 crore from APGENCO for Rayalaseema Thermal Power Project
- BoP order worth Rs. 723.0 crore from APGENCO for Kakatiya Thermal power Project

For APGENCO Kakatiya Thermal Power Project Stage II (1x600 MW), the design, engineering, manufacturing, procurement, testing at manufacturer's works, supply, delivery, transportation to site, transit and site storage insurance, storage, construction, erection, testing at site, commissioning and handing over of Balance of Plant including civil works.
