### **Tecpro Systems Limited Receives Orders Worth Rs. 791.5 million comprising (1) Rs. 513.0 million from SEPCO Electric Power Construction Corporation and (2) Rs. 278.5 million from NMDC Limited**

**Gurgaon, November 09, 2010:** Tecpro Systems Limited (Tecpro), a key player in the material handling sector, providing turnkey solutions in material handling, coal and ash handling, Balance of Plant (BOP) and which undertakes Engineering, Procurement & Construction (EPC) contracts in the power sector, has announced that it has bagged orders worth Rs. 791.5 million. For NMDC Limited, the Engineering, Procurement, Fabrication, Inspection, Packing, Supply, Transportation to Site and Storage of all Plant & Equipment including Electrics, Civil and Structural Works, Handling, Insurance, Erection Testing, Successful Commissioning and Performance Guarantee Tests for installation of New Fine Ore Conveyors 315N-1, 315N-2, BC-3B & 316A and associated facilities on Lump Sum Turnkey Basis at Bailadila Iron Ore Mine Kirandul Complex, District Dantewada, Chhattisgarh State.
